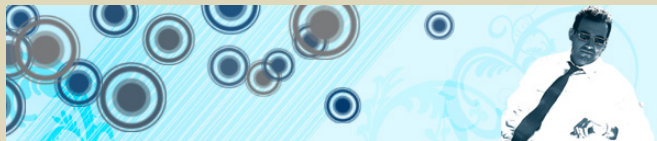
Chicken Soup Dinner 6:15 pm
